<u>Jaguarundi</u>	Arizona, Costa Rica, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Texas
<u>Killer Whale</u>	Southern Resident DPS (Canada, USA - WA)
<u>Mantled Howler Monkey</u>	Mexico to South America
<u>Margay</u>	Central and South America, Mexico
<u>Mexican Bobcat</u>	Central Mexico
<u>Ocelot</u>	USA (Arizona, Texas) to Central and South America

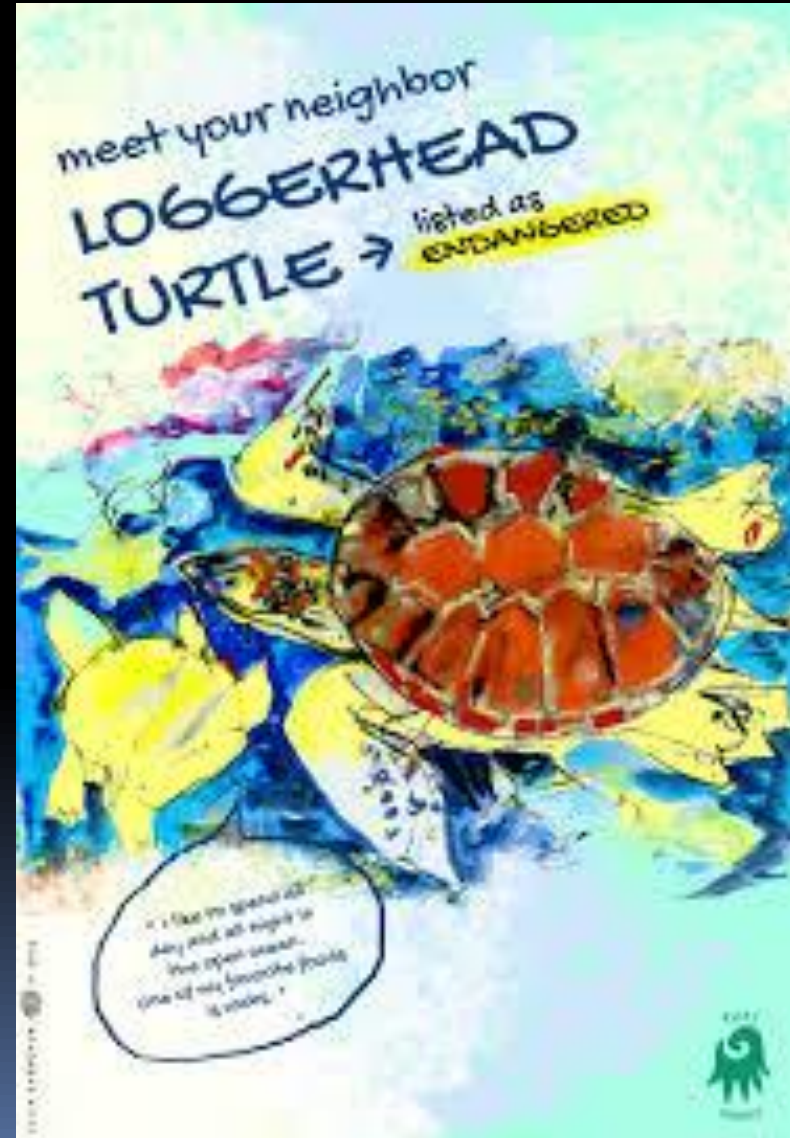

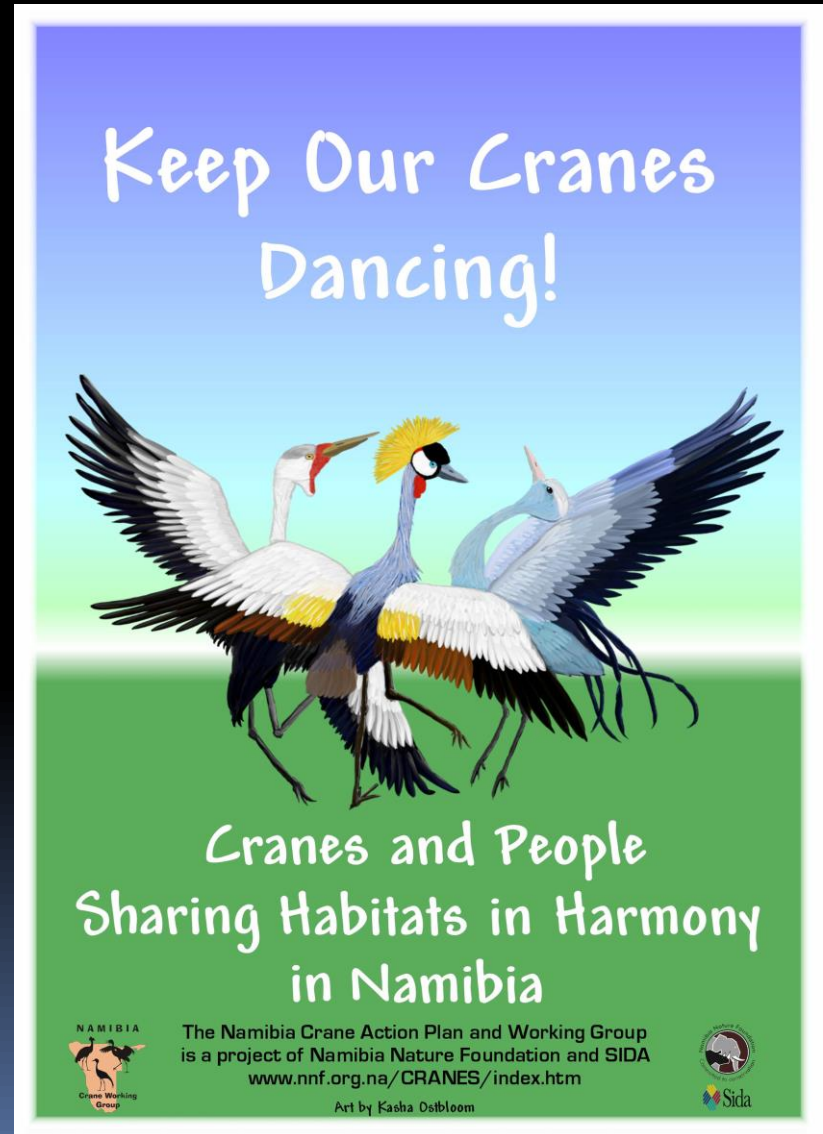
Your task is to create a public service poster to raise awareness of threatened and endangered animals.
