FAMILY HISTORY CRITERIA CHART

- 10 interview questions. DUE JANUARY 15
- Synopsis complete. DUE JANUARY 17
- Screenplay complete. DUE JANUARY 28
 - Accurate use of screenplay format
 - 3-4 pages
- Storyboard completed. DUE JANUARY 31
 - Every shot sketched
 - Dialogue, action, FX, SFX noted
- Production Completed on time. DUE FEBRUARY 21
 - Equipment returned on time and in good condition
 - Tripod and boom used
- Rough Edit completed on time. DUE MARCH 17
 - At least 3 components used: Interviews; Dramatizations; Voiceover Narration; Text, sound, music; Related media (created/archival video and photos)
 - 3-4 minutes long without title and credits
 - Rule of Thirds used to compose images
 - Varied camera angles and shots
 - Still images clear and high resolution
 - Video in focus
 - Accurate continuity
 - Dialogue clear, undistorted and balanced
 - Voiceover clear, undistorted and balanced
- Final Edit completed. DUE MARCH 26
 - All revisions completed
 - Titles legible
 - Credits complete and legible
 - Sound levels balanced
 - Transitions added
 - Keyframe animation used for still images
 - Program 3-4 minutes long without title and credits
- Video Output. DUE MARCH 26.
 - Exported as a MP4 file
