RENAISSANCE PORTRAIT PROCEDURES

PREPARING THE DESKTOP

- 1. Create new folder on desktop.
- 2. Label folder "YOUR NAME RENAISSANCE PORTRAIT."
- 3. Go to portolamedia.weebly.com and select DIGITAL IMAGING link.
- 4. Place the Renaissance image you want to work with in this folder.

CREATING THE PHOTOGRAPHIC IMAGE

- 5. Create rough sketch of image for photograph head position and lighting.
- 6. Take 5 photographs in which the head position and lighting match the Renaissance image.
- 7. Create a new folder on desktop.
- 8. Label folder, "YOUR NAME RENAISSANCE PHOTOS."
- Transfer photos from camera to computer and place in RENAISSANCE PHOTOS folder.
- 10. Rename photo you want to work with "CHOICE."
- 11. Drag into RENAISSANCE PORTRAIT folder.

CREATING THE COMPOSITE IMAGE IN PHOTOSHOP

- 12. Open Photoshop.
- 13. Create new document.
- 14. Label document YOUR NAME RENAISSANCE PORTRAIT.
- 15. Select Custom size.
- 16. Enter Width 13 inches, Height 19 inches, then Create.
- 17. Drag the Renaissance image into Photoshop.
- 18. Press SHIFT and drag the corner of the image until it covers the entire page.
- 19. Place the image.
- 20. Copy the image by dragging the image layer onto the CREATE NEW LAYER icon at the bottom of the Layers Panel.

- 21. Shut down the original image layer. Work only on the copied layer.
- 22. Select the MAGNETIC LASSO TOOL.
- 23. Set FEATHER to 3 px.
- 24. Use the MAGNETIC LASSO TOOL to select the face.
- 25. When the marching ants appear choose SELECT from the menu bar and INVERSE.
- 26. Select ADD LAYER MASK at the bottom of the Layers Panel.
- 27. Drag the photo of yourself into Photoshop.
- 28. Press SHIFT and drag the corner of the image so that the size of your head is slightly larger than the head in the image.
- 29. Drag the photo layer under the image layer.
- 30. Use the MOVE TOOL to scale and position your face so that it fits on the Renaissance image layer.
- 31. Use the BRUSH TOOL to clean up the mask in the image layer.
- 32. Use ADJUSTMENT LAYERS on the photo layer to adjust the brightness and contrast, levels, hue, and saturation.
- 33. Use the CLONE STAMP, SMUDGE, BURN, DODGE, and BLUR TOOLS to retouch the image.
- 34. Add a filter to the photo to create a more painterly effect. The Paint Daubs filter in Artistic Filters was used in the sample.

OUTPUTTING THE FINAL ARTWORK

- 35. Save document in the YOUR NAME RENAISSANCE PORTRAIT folder on the desktop as a tiff and jpeg.
- 36. After your portrait is printed, you will place a mat on the portrait and affix a name label on the mat.
