#### **WORKING WITH SHAPES**

## **SHAPE LAYER (1ST BOX)**

- 1. Creates a shape on a new layer.
- 2. Default style is a shape filled in with foreground color
- 3. Change style or add more styles by appending.

## PATHS (2<sup>ND</sup> BOX)

- 1. Creates an invisible shape on a new layer.
- 2. You can type around this shape. Your words take the shape of the path.

#### **FILL PIXELS**

- 1. First, add a new layer or add a shape to the current layer. Don't use the background layer.
- 2. Your shape will be filled with the foreground color.
- 3. Use Layer Styles to change the fill. You can change color, add gradients, patterns, etc.

# **MARQUEE SELECTION**

- 1. First, add a new layer.
- 2. Select the Rectangular or Elliptical Marquee tool (2<sup>nd</sup> from top on toolbar). This creates a selection. Note the "marching ants."
- 3. Select EDIT>STROKE to create an outline around your selection.
- 4. Control the thickness of the outline by entering a value in the WIDTH box.
- 5. Select a color by clicking on the COLOR BOX.
- 6. COMMAND +D to exit selection, leaving the outlined shape
